- by Dr. D. N. Mullick, D.Sc., F.R.S.E., with the Hon. Sir Richard Harington as Chairman. It was liberally illustrated by lantern-slides, and proved very successful. The third lecture was delivered on the 21st February by the Rev. J. Mitchell, M.A., F.R.A.S., his subject being "Comets." Justice Sir Ashutosh Mookerjee was in the chair. This, the concluding lecture for the session, was illustrated with a most remarkable series of lantern-slides and made a profound impression on the audience present.
- (c) A Conversazione was held at the Town Hall, on the 29th January 1913, where a collection of drawings, photographs, instruments and other objects of interest was put up. A detailed account of it appeared in the February issue of the JOURNAL.
