FORESEE AND AVOID POSSIBLE RISKS

Assess storage I display surroundings for potential problems like water, pests, mold, I breakage. Relocate your treasures or take other measures to reduce risks.

MAKE A DUPLICATE

Copy treasures like photographs, newspapers, I letters when possible I appropriate. Store the original safely I use the copy. Digital copies allow treasures to be easily shared, but remember digital items need preservation too.

ASK A PROFESSIONAL

Seek, professional advice before trying at home repairs of cleaning treasures yourself.

VISIT YOUR LIBRARY
